INSTALLATION & OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

(1) TOOLS AND MATERIALS REQUIRED

- ❖ BLADE SCREW DRIVER
- ❖ WIRE CUTTERS
- ❖ WIRING SUPPLIES AS REQUIRED BY ELECTRICAL CODE

Attention:

Before assembling your lighting fixture, please read the following instructions. If you feel you do not have sufficient electrical experience, refer to a do-it-yourself wiring handbook or have your fixture installed by a qualified licensed electrician.

(2) GENERAL

1. To ensure the success of the installation, be sure to read these instructions and review the diagrams thoroughly before beginning.
2. All electrical connections must be in accordance with local codes, ordinances, or the National Electrical Code. If you are unfamiliar with methods of installing electrical wiring, secure the services of a qualified licensed electrician.
3. These fixtures are intended for mounting to a standard 4" x 2 1/4" deep metal octagon outlet box. The box must be directly supported by the building and U.L. Recognized.
4. Before commencing with the installation, **disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker** or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Turning the power off using the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock or risk of fire.
5. Save these **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS** and refer to them when additions to or changes in the fixture configuration are made.
6. Do not install this fixture in hazardous locations.
7. Do not install any fixture assembly closer than 6 inches from any curtain or similar combustible material.

NOTE:

The important safeguards and instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and care, are factors that cannot be built into any product. These factors must be supplied by the person(s) caring for and operating the fixture.

(3) UNPACKING THE FIXTURE

On checking the contents of the box you will find;

- ❖ Fixture assembly
- ❖ Mounting Plate
- ❖ Mounting hardware package
- ❖ Fixture housing
- ❖ G-9/40W bulb x 1,2,3,4,5 (Model Dependant).

(4) PREPARE THE FIXTURE

Refer to figure 1 for illustration of fixture parts and assembly.

1. If you are replacing an existing fixture, disconnect and remove the old fixture. Expose the supply wiring from the junction box.
2. Expose the Supply wires through the center hole in the Fixture **Mounting Plate**. Secure the Fixture Mounting Plate to the junction box with the supplied **Mounting Screws**.
3. Provide added support to the Fixture Mounting Plate by placing **screws** into the two slotted holes on either end of the Fixture Mounting Plate.
4. **Wiring:**
 - Connect the **BLACK** supply wire to the **Black** wire of the fixture with supplied **wire nuts**. Ensuring a secure connection.
 - Connect the **WHITE** supply wire to the **White** fixture wire and secure with the supplied wire nuts..
 - Attach the **ground (GREEN)** wire from the fixture to the junction box ground terminal (or to the box ground wire) or attach both of **ground (GREEN)** wire directly to the **green screw** on the mounting plate.
 - Secure all **wire nuts** connections with **UL listed electrical tape** (not supplied). Tuck wires carefully into junction box.
5. Fit the **fixture housing** over the **mounting plate**. Align the upper and lower holes in both the fixture housing and **mounting plate**. Secure with the **4 screws** provided.
6. To insert the G9 bulb, first unscrew the bulb cover. Then insert the **G9 bulb** into the lamp holder.
7. Replace the **bulb cover** by screwing it on the lamp holder.
8. Restore electricity and check the operation of your new lighting fixture.
9. When **Re-Lamping** follow steps 6 and 7.

CAUTION:

- **Ensure that the Fitting is Cool and Switched off, Before Changing the Halogen Bulb.**
- **Do Not use Bulbs Exceeding Maximum Wattage, As Per Caution Label.**
- **Do Not Touch the Halogen Bulb while fixture is in operation.**
- **Do Not Operate the Lighting Fixture close to any Combustible Material.**
